Directions

Northwest- take 270 West (towards Grove City) to I-70 East (toward Columbus) Merge onto US-33 (toward Lancaster) take a slight left onto Winchester Pike and Refugee Road.

Northeast- take 270 East onto US-33 West (towards Bexley) get off on the Refugee Road East exit then right on Winchester Pike.

North-(Sunbury) take 71 South-merge onto I-70 East (towards Wheeling) to US-33 (toward Lancaster) then take a slight left on Winchester Pike.

Grove City- Jackson Pike/OH-104 becomes Refugee Road-take a right at Winchester Pike.

Pataskala- 310 South Main St. to I-70 West to US-33 East (towards Lancaster) to OH-104 West which becomes Refugee Road. Turn right on Winchester Pike.

Lancaster- East Main St/OH-188 to US-33 West to Refugee Road East exit, slight right onto Refugee Road and then a right on Winchester Pike.

Pickerington- West Columbus St/OH-256 left on Diley Rd. onto US-33 West/Columbus Lancaster Rd. Take the Refugee Rd East exit then right on Winchester Pike.
